Building a Logic Model for Programs Targeting Young Vulnerable Children and Their Caregivers

Problem statement: There are many children in the community under the age of 8 who have lost their biological parents and are living without appropriate care by a consistent caregiver. As a result these children often lack the support they need to access critical services. Caregivers report a high level of stress due to lack of resources and other forms of support. Because of these factors children are at risk of not reaching their developmental potential.

INPUT

- Knowledge of children's needs
 & the importance of caregiver/child attachment
- Financial & human resources for program outreach, targeting the most vulnerable young children
- Equipment & transportation

Program Level

ACTIVITY

- Train program staff on ECD
- Identify human resources for program outreach, including volunteers & other community workers
- Map available services in the community
- Establish comprehensive referral system to ensure children & caregivers receive necessary support
- Volunteers & others make home visits & provide support to caregivers
- Register all children so that they may access public services

OUTPUT

- Children have increased access to health, social welfare, and legal services and are registered
- Caregivers have increased knowledge on appropriate child rearing practices
- Children have adequate nutrition
- Children have access to early learning experiences, including community based child care centers.
